**RHAM Chromebook Self Insurance Program**  
**Administrative Regulation 6141.32**

The manufacturer's warranty covers manufacturer defects and problems due to normal use and wear up to a period of 1 year from date of purchase.

The RHAM Self Insurance Program covers accidental damage and breakage.

**Yearly RHAM Self Insurance Program Costs**

- The insurance program cost \$25.00 per school year (non-refundable). This is intended to provide accidental damage including, but not limited to a cracked or broken screen, liquid spills, missing keys. The initial insurance fee will be waived for students eligible for free or reduced lunch. Students on free or reduced lunch will be responsible for any additional insurance costs.
- To participate in the insurance program, families must enroll their child(ren) by September 30.
- If a student is NOT enrolled in the insurance program, they will be responsible for the full cost of all repairs not covered by the Manufacturer's Warranty, or full replacement cost if the Chromebook is lost or stolen.
- If a student withdraws from Regional School District 8 and then re-enrolls later in the same school year, Insurance will be reinstated.

**Program Coverage**

- If a student is enrolled in the RHAM Self Insurance Program, a loaner device will be provided while their Chromebook is being repaired.
- The insurance applies to any Chromebook issued to your son/daughter by Regional School District 8, whether it is the originally issued Chromebook, a loaner, or a replacement.
- The Insurance will cover up to two replacements of the items listed below. After that, another insurance policy must be purchased to maintain coverage for that school year.

**Approximate Replacement Costs:**

- Replacement Chromebook ~\$249
- Replacement Screen ~\$60
- Replacement Upper Case, Keyboard, Trackpad ~\$85
- Replacement Lower Case ~\$30
- Replacement Battery ~\$30
- Replacement Charger ~\$50
- Replacement Bag ~\$40

**Damage to Non-Insured Chromebooks**

- Students opting not to buy the RHAM Self Insurance Program are responsible for repair or full replacement costs. During repair, the student will be issued a loaner device that must be returned at the end of each school day.
